Our project for 2024-2025 is to provide Mini Libraries for the Talita Cumi Girls Clubs in Latin America. Our goal is to raise \$15,000 by the end of Conference (July 25-27, 2025). It is not to late to give toward this project. A gift of \$355 will provide 1 complete library with approximately 76 books.

A gift of \$710 will provide 2 complete libraries.

A gift of \$1,420 will provide 4 complete libraries.

A gift of \$3,550 will provide 10 complete libraries
